TU emerges Champion in 1st Inter-Univ Cricket Tournament

Arkajit of TU selected Man of the Match for stellar performance

In a thrilling cricket match, Tripura University emerged as the best in the Northeast. The university's cricket team clinched a nail-biting victory over Guwahati University by a narrow margin of 5 runs in the final match of the North-East Zone Inter-University Men's Cricket Tournament held at Rajiv Gandhi University in Arunachal Pradesh.

The match, held on Wednesday, saw Tripura University winning the toss and electing to bat first. The team put up a commendable score of 156 runs for the loss of 7 wickets in the stipulated 20 overs. Tanmoy Das's brilliant batting played a pivotal role in Tripura's impressive score. Das scored a quick fire 52 runs off 41

balls, including 5 fours and 2 sixes. Adding to the team's total, Bipin Kumar Sharma remained unbeaten with a score of 26 runs off just 11 balls, including 2 fours and 2 sixes. Arkaprabha Sinha also contributed a handy 23 runs off 24 balls, including 2 fours and 1 six. Guwahati University's bowlers, Prasher Changmai and Jaideep Singh, managed to take 2 wickets each, giving away 24 and 31 runs respectively. In response, Guwahati University

fell short of the target by 5 runs and managed to score only 151 runs before being bowled out in 19.4 overs. Kokil K Gogoi top-scored for the team with 34 runs off 18 balls. His innings included 2 fours and 3 sixes. Gaurav Saikiya and Jaideep Singh also made significant contributions with scores of 27 and 29 runs respectively.

However, the star of the match was undoubtedly Arkajit Roy of Tripura University. Roy single-handedly demolished the Guwahati University batting line-up, taking an impressive 6 wickets for just 19 runs. His exceptional performance earned him the well-deserved Man of the Match award. Madhu Manik Lodh, representing Tripura University, extended his hearty congratulations to the triumphant cricketers on their achievement of becoming the best in the Northeast.

Agartala: Feb 17. The stage is set for the commencement of the three-day 'Khelo India University Games 2023' Yoga Competition, scheduled to kick off on Sunday in the state. The prestigious event will take place at the indoor hall of the Netaji Subhas Regional Coaching Center (NSRCC), Agartala, continuing through February 20.

Speaking to media persons at Civil Secretariat here, Secretary of the Youth Affairs and Sports department Dr Pradip Kumar Chakraborty made the official announcement and highlighted that the 'Khelo India University Games' stands as a multifaceted sporting spectacle, drawing participation from universities across the nation in a diverse array of

disciplines.

The fourth edition of the Khelo India University Games, themed around the 'Ashtalakshmi' states of the North Eastern region, will feature 20 events. Notable disciplines include Athletics, Rugby, Basketball, Volleyball, Swimming, Badminton, and Yoga, among others. The Yoga competition, specifically, will take place in the scenic backdrop of Tripura.

The collaboration between the state government's Department of Youth Affairs and Sports and Tripura University underscores the meticulous planning behind the event. Dr. Chakraborty revealed that approximately 160 athletes hailing from 13 universities across India will vie for top honors in the Yoga competition. 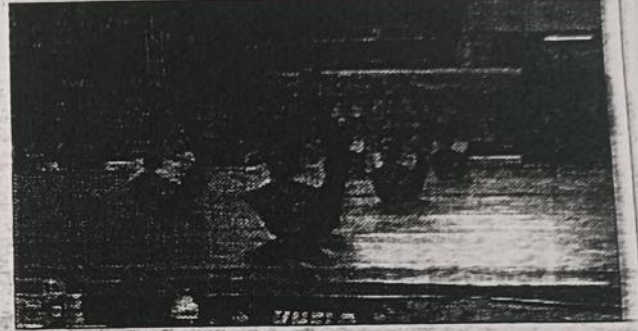
