# Be problem-solvers, Nallu told students

Agartala, Sep 8: Tripura University celebrated its 13th Convocation with a grand ceremony held at the Maharaja Bir Bikram Shatabarshiki Bhawan inside the university campus.

The event commenced with the national anthem, followed by the inauguration by Governor, Indrasena Reddy

Nallu accompanied by several other dignitaries like Chancellor Ahmed Javed, Vice Chancellor Ganga Prasad Prasad, and Registrar Dr. Dipak Sharma. The convocation was formally declared open by Chancellor Ahmed Javed, after which Vice Chancellor Prasad delivered the welcome address and presented the annual report. Following the welcome address, degrees and

medals were presented to PhD scholars, postgraduate, and undergraduate students by the Chief Guest and Chancellor.

In his address, Governor Indrasena Reddy Nallu encouraged students to embrace life's challenges and emphasized the importance of resilience and determination. "As we embark on this journey, we must remember that

He urged the students to focus on becoming innovators and problem-solvers, highlighting the need for research and innovation in the digital age, while also warning of the rising concern of cybercrimes. He emphasized that acquiring skills, knowledge, and critical thinking should take precedence over merely earning certificates. Chancellor Ahmed Javed, in his speech, praised the university's commitment not only to education but also to social service. He lauded the faculty and students for their response to the recent floods in Tripura, particularly highlighting the invention of a portable water purifier by a faculty member. This innovation, which provided WHO-standard safe drinking water, played a crucial role in flood-relief efforts, assisting the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) in their mission across the affected areas. In his speech, the Vice Chancellor Ganga Prasad emphasized the academic progress of the university, announcing the launch of two new postgraduate departments in Liberal Arts and Archaeology & Ancient History this year. He also highlighted the significant increase in student admissions across various disciplines, noting that the Master of Arts program saw an impressive intake of 850 students. The Vice Chancellor further reported on the results of the previous academic year in the MA, MSc, and postgraduate commerce programs, while congratulating the students on their achievements. The event concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Registrar Dr. Deepak Sharma, followed by the national anthem. This year's convocation reflected Tripura University's academic growth and its active engagement in community service, inspiring students to become agents of positive change in society.

# Relief distribution by TU economics alumni

A large number of people in the area have lost their houses, belongings, and means of subsistence as a result of the devastating weather event.
