The Faculty Induction Programme is the priority action aimed at improving the professional capability and performance of teachers to deliver effective and quality learning.

Taking into consideration the long cherished demands of the students community, growing aspirations of the people at large and also acknowledging the present and future needs of education in the state, the State Government took the initiative to pass the Tripura University Act in the Assembly in 1987 and the first University in the state came into being on 2nd October 1987. Later Tripura University has been converted to a Central University w.e.f. 2nd July, 2007 under the Tripura University Act, 2006 as enacted by the Parliament. At present there are five faculties, forty four Departments and four Centres of Study in the University. As a conventional University, Tripura University has taken upon itself the responsibility to preserve and promote the enviable heritage of the state's indigenous art forms, folk, oral and multi-dimensional cultural traditions. In order to adapt with the demands of the changing times, the University is gradually changing over to e-governance for efficient, accurate and eco-friendly administration.
