On the recommendation of the Selection Committee, the Council is pleased to award the Short Term ICMR-DHR International Fellowship for Senior Indian Biomedical Scientists for the year 2019-20 to Dr. Mrinal Kanti Bhowmik, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Tripura University, Suryamaninagar-799022, Tripura for training in the lab of Prof. Niharika Nath, New York Institute of Technology, Department of Life Sciences, New York, USA. He will avail the fellowship for a period of 1 Month w.e.f. 26th December, 2019 to 25th January, 2020.

A copy of Political Clearance from Ministry of External Affairs is enclosed herewith.

The terms and conditions are as follows:

1. The period of stay in USA should not exceed beyond the period mentioned above excluding actual travel time.
2. The fellow is entitled for the following expenses on his training at the above mentioned laboratory in USA.
 - a. The expenditure on Air travel in economy class (excursion fare) from the place of duty to USA and back.
 - b. Fellowship @US \$3000 p.m. for 1 month of which 90% of the fellowship amount will be transferred directly in your account by R.T.G.S.
 - c. Contingency amount upto Rs. 50,000/- for Visa-fee, Overseas medi-claim insurance, taxi fare from the place of duty to Air Port & back on submission of original receipts/bills. No other charges/expenditure are admissible.
3. An acknowledgement of the same (on receipt) at 'b' above should be sent to the Council before commencing the journey.
4. The Fellow will not be allowed to draw any part of his salary abroad.
5. The Fellow should send the original bills duly verified/signed by himself on expenses under 'contingency head', to the Council immediately after performing the foreign visit.

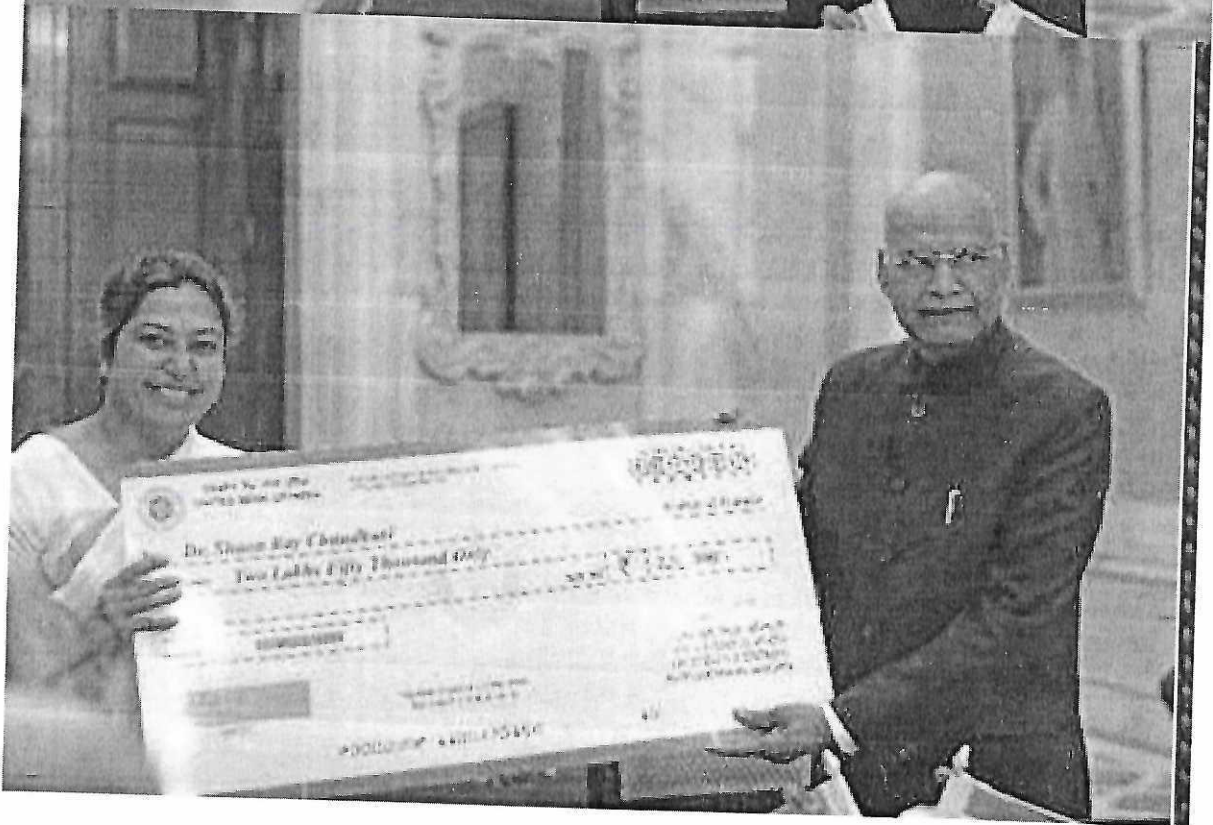

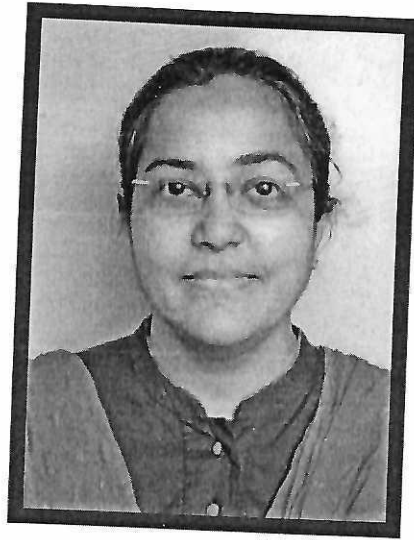

The Visitor's Award for Technology Development for the year 2019 is being awarded to Prof. Shaon Ray Chaudhuri, Tripura University for developing Microbial Biofilm Reactor for conversion of dairy wastewater into biofertilizer. Her approach makes dairy wastewater management not only self-sustainable zero discharge process but also a profit earning venture. The scalability was tested up to 7300 liters. The technology has been demonstrated in two states (Agartala and Bhubaneswar) at a pilot scale. Irrigation using the treated effluent resulted in 2.6 fold increase in seed yield in Mung bean during pot trial and 1.5 fold increase in field trial for both Mung bean and black gram when compared to chemical fertilizer yield while providing protection from aphid infestation. Her technology would ensure profit for dairy industry with environmental sustenance, organic farming and saving of fresh water and rock phosphate for other essential applications. This would also take care of the growing food requirement.



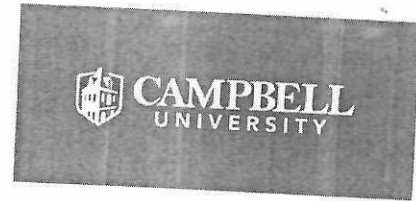

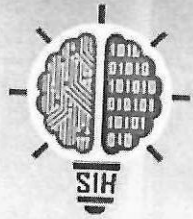
