## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) and Answers for Candidates Seeking Admission in MBA Programme (2019-20)

1. What is the process of application seeking admission in MBA Programme of Tripura University?  
Answer: Through online mode only ([www.tripurauniv.in](http://www.tripurauniv.in) ). Enrolment for the academic session (2019-20) starts on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2019 (12.00 midnight) close on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2019 (12.00 midnight)
2. What is the process of admission in MBA, Tripura University?  
Answer: Any national entrance test (MAT, CMAT, CET etc) or TUET (Tripura University Entrance Test) followed by Group Discussion and Personal Interview. Preference would be accorded to the candidates with a valid score card of any national level entrance test as mentioned above.
3. Is there any marks criteria for admission in MBA, Tripura University?  
Answer: Yes, Minimum 50% marks in graduation (5% relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/EWS).
4. What is the date of TUET for the academic session 2019-20?  
Answer: Tentatively the examination will be held any day between 29<sup>th</sup> June and 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2019.
5. Who can apply for MBA Programme of Tripura University?  
Answer: Candidates completed graduation in any stream with 50% marks/waiting finalresults (50% overall must)of graduation.
6. Is it a regular Course?  
Answer: Yes, MBA offered by Tripura University is a fulltime program approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi. The course spans across four semesters and blended in Theory, Practice and Industry exposure.
7. What are the specializations offered in MBA, Tripura University?  
Answer: At present we offer four specializations namely Marketing, Finance, Human Resource Management and System management. Among which Marketing is compulsory and students need to pick any one from the remaining.
8. What will be the date of counselling cum admission for MBA, Tripura University?  
Answer: 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
9. How many total seats available for admission in MBA, Tripura University?  
Answer: 60 (intake)+10% of 60 (i.e. 6) only for EWS in upper caste as per criteria stipulated by Government of India.
10. What is the reservation policy for admission in MBA, Tripura University?

Answer: As per Government of India rule of reservation.

11. What is the total course fee for MBA, Tripura University?

Answer: The total course fee of MBA in Tripura university is Rs 1, 39,000/- (One lakh thirty-nine thousand only). It is to be paid in four equal instalments of Rs. 34,750/- (Thirty-four thousand seven hundred fifty only) per semester.

12. What will be the mode of TUET examination?

Answer: The TUET examination will be conducted in ONLINE mode only. The medium of instructions will be in English only. There will be 25-30 examination centres to be located within India from which a candidate can select.

13. What is the cost of prospectus?

Answer: The cost of prospectus (e-copy) as well as hardcopy is Rs. 600/- (six hundred only) for ST & SC. Rs.800/- (eight hundred only) for GEN, OBC and EWS.

14. What will be the pattern of questions in TUET exam?

Answer: There will be around 50 multiple choice questions carrying 2 marks each. (No negative markings).

15. How can a foreign candidate seek admission in MBA, Tripura University?

Answer: Kindly contact with admission co-ordinator, Student admission cell, Tripura University (contact details available on Tripura University website).

16. Whether candidate can avail any scholarship?

Answer: Since Tripura university is a Central University, all Government schemes of scholarship is equally applicable for the aspirants and will be notified on appropriate time upon admission.

17. How many courses of Tripura University a candidate can apply at a time?

Answer: A candidate can apply to maximum 3 (three) courses at a time provided he/she needs to pay the prospectus fee for all the three courses applied. Candidate also need to ensure that the date of online entrance test do not collide. Upon shortlisting a candidate must communicate his/her final choice of course.
