Proceedings of the Emergent Meeting of the Academic Council held on 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 at 01:00 P.M. in the Council Hall, Administrative Building, Tripura University:

At the outset of the meeting, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor welcomed the members to the Emergent Meeting of the Academic Council. He specially thanked to the members attending the meeting of the Council for the first time.

He then conveyed to the house the reasons in brief for holding such emergent meeting of the Council in a short span of time. He expressed that the present situation created by a college namely, Tripurasundari College of Nursing, Tulakona in different ways such as, in affiliation, publication of results and protest conducted by few students, have affected academic environment of the University. For this situation, efforts should be taken immediately. In this regard, the resolutions of previous Academic Council Meetings and all the verdicts of the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura were placed before the members for deliberation.

With due respect to the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura against the case No. WP(C) 718 of 2017, Tripurasundari College of Nursing Versus The State of Tripura and Ors, the members after a prolonged discussion, reached at the following conclusion:


- 1) In respect to the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura on 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 and subsequently the resolution taken in the Academic Council in its 20<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 (under agenda 14/20/2017), the students of 1<sup>st</sup> year B.Sc. Nursing of Tripurasundari College of Nursing, Tulakona were allowed to appear in the examination, scheduled from 20<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2017, at the examination centre of Tripura Institute of Paramedical Science (TIPS).


Considering/following the final Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura, dated 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2017, the Academic Council of Tripura University in its emergent meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2018, advise to publish the result of all those students who appeared in the aforesaid examination under provisional registration pursuant to the judgement of Hon'ble High Court.

They had been enrolled in Tripurasundari College of Nursing (TSCN), Tulakona, Tripura, notwithstanding the fact that the TSCN has no affiliation from Tripura University but its enrolled students were given provisional registration only under Hon'ble High Court's order.

- 2) Academic Council further resolves to request the Hon'ble Court to permit T.U. to accommodate students (referred above who were given provisional registration by the University), under its other affiliating Nursing Colleges, to facilitate their further study.
- 3) Academic Council resolves to request the Hon'ble Court to consider the matter of transfer of the fees collected from the students by TSCN for transferring the same proportionately to other colleges, where the students will laterally complete their study.
- 4) Academic Council resolves to pray to the Hon'ble Court to consider the position of T.U. which is the affiliating University and appreciate its position that students enrolled (if any) by TSCN in 2017-18 session without affiliation from T.U. should not be made responsibility of T.U.
- 5) Academic Council further resolves that the issue of affiliation to TSCN will be taken up for evaluation only after proper and complete compliance by TSCN of all the suggestions/recommendations put forward to it by the Inspection Team from T.U.
- 6) Academic Council resolves that T.U. will be appraising all developments relating to TSCN to the Indian Nursing Council (INC) at the earliest.
- 7) Academic Council resolves to appeal to the Hon'ble Supreme Court with all above concerns vis-a-vis TSCN.

The Emergent Meeting came to an end with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
